What? Taking on a challenge called the 'Talisker Whiskey Atlantic Challenge'. This is a solo row across the Atlantic Ocean covering 3,000 miles and lasting approximately 90 days.

Where? Travelling from La Gomera in the Canary Islands to Antigua in the Caribbean. He will be rowing 18 hours a day for 90 days, during which he will be alone at sea.

When? Sets sail in December 2022

Why? To raise awareness and bring hope to young people who have mental health issues by visiting schools across the UK. He is also doing it to raise money for the Samaritans (to develop a package of support for young people in the UK) and the LOVE



rowing charity (to support inclusive rowing programmes for underrepresented communities).
