AS part of our Careers Education (CEIAG) programme, we are inviting all Year 11 students to attend a trip to The University of Liverpool. This will enable students to gain an insight into and experience of a place of Higher Education.

We are also linking this with one of our Learning for Life key skills of independent travel, as we will be travelling to and from the venue on a public bus, which the school will fund.
