## Aims:

- For students to be able to share an interest or something that they like with a peer.
- For students to be able to recall three things about a peer.
- For students to be able to ask a peer a question about the other person's interests/ preferences.

Activity	Procedure	Equipment
Memory Game	Remind the students of the bean bag game from last session.  Sit in a circle. Place the cards that you wrote on last week in the centre of the group. Take it in turns to take a card – the student must try to match the interest with a peer. If they have their own interest, get them to choose another card.	Cards with interests written on them
	At the end of the activity, ask the students how it felt when another person remembered what they like. If this is too difficult provide a forced choice e.g. Did it feel good or bad?
